Car Parking

If you look for the mobile zip wire crane you can walk down the pavement at the back of the car park to reach the registration point. Follow the green line on the map below.

Before Your Experience

- ✓ Confirmation Email: Check that your confirmation email states the correct location, time, and date – we wouldn't want you to turn up at the wrong place! Also check that you have provided the correct contact number to your organisations representative or with us if you booked directly in case we need to contact you before or on the day of your experience
- ✓ Health Warning Notice: Read the Health Warning Notice which can be found at the bottom of this pack and make sure that you are fit enough to participate. If any of the health warning notice applies, then you must seek professional medical advice prior to your Zip Wire. On the day of your experience, you will be required to sign a "non-standard" waiver stating you have done this.
- ✓ Accommodation & Transport: When booking accommodation or transport please be aware that Big Bang Promotions cannot be held responsible for any accommodation, transport or other charges that you incur in the case of a cancelled event.
- ✓ Plan your journey: We have included directions, but it is always a good idea to check the time that it will take you to arrive as if you are late, we may not be able to accommodate your experience.
- ✓ Cancelled Events: Occasionally we sometimes have to cancel our events due to weather, mechanical failure, low participant numbers and unexpected events. In the rare event that we do have to cancel your event we will endeavour to contact you as soon as possible

The Day of Your Zip Wire

Here at Big Bang Experiences, we want you to have the best day possible so below is some information that will help to make sure that your day runs smoothly.

- ✓ Arrival: It is important that you arrive 30 minutes before your experience time.
- ✓ Duration: We ask you to allow between 2 and 3 hours on site. This allows us to prepare you for your experience and hopefully covers any unexpected delays that we may be experiencing on the day.
- ✓ Confirmation Email: Please bring your confirmation email on the day as proof of booking.
- ✓ Spectators: Please feel free to bring as many spectators as you want – the more the merrier.
- ✓ Clothing: Make sure that you dress according to the weather – we wouldn't want you to be too hot or cold! It's advised that you dress in comfortable clothes, skirts are not recommended! Please try to ensure any long hair is tied back and you don't wear any excessively loose clothing that may become entangled with any rigging or ropes.
- ✓ Loose Articles: Before you are placed in a harness it is important that you empty your pockets of any loose articles and remove absolutely all pieces of jewellery. Please minimise these before registration by leaving them in your vehicle or handing them to friends or family. If for any reason you are unable to remove a piece of jewellery, please speak to a member of staff.
- ✓ Toilets – there are toilets at the museum and some portable toilets at the registration area.

HEALTH WARNING NOTICE

IF IN DOUBT - DON'T ZIP

If you are not in good health, you should **NOT** Zip Line.

You can **NOT zip line if you are:**

- Under 10 years old
- Pregnant
- Under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs

If any of the following apply, **you must seek professional medical advice before participating and sign a non-standard waiver:**

- High blood pressure
- Heart condition
- Suffer from dizziness or epilepsy
- Damage to neck, back, spinal column, legs or eyes
- Asthma
- Medication – if you are taking any form of prescribed medication, please inform us of how this may affect you
- Aged 50 years or above - we strongly advise that you seek medical advice prior to taking part

The following points apply to **ALL participants:**

- Participants aged 10 - 15 years old require a parent or guardian to be present, sign permission and will be required to complete a non-standard waiver
- Minimum participant weight is 30kg (4.7 stone)
- Maximum participant weight is 120kg (18.9 stone)
- Waist harnesses fit waist size of 40cm (15.7 inches) to 120cm (47.2 inches)
- Participants should be willing to ride in a man basket to the zip height of up to 150ft
