**We are looking for parents who have a child with a condition caused by a de novo (new) genetic change.** The chance of this happening again in a future pregnancy is currently given as an average risk. **We invite both or either parent, including fathers.** Those from an ethnic minority (including white minorities, such as Gypsy, Roma and Irish Traveller groups) are often under-represented in research and we would particularly welcome their participation.
